Starting in 2004 with the donation of their dilapidated 1935 dairy barn to the Uniontown Community Development Association, Steve and Junette Dahmen

stipulated that it be stabilized and put to a community use.

Through successful grant writing, community commitment, and countless volunteer hours, the Artisans at the Dahmen Barn opened in 2006 as a creativity center featuring resident artisans, classes, live music, and exhibitions.



Ten years later, in 2016, we are celebrating the completion of The Loafing Shed addition, which houses more artists’ studios; a performance, class and event space; and a commercial kitchen offering culinary classes for children and adults.

Today, the Barn features 13 studios with 25 resident artists. Meet them and their work in person or on our website.

Our schedule includes concerts, art exhibitions, adult and children’s cooking classes, adult and children’s ceramics classes, art classes throughout the year, and special events such as the Gift Gala in December featuring resident and

invited guest artists, and the Art Demo Day in April. The Shop at the Barn offers art and fine craft works from over 150 regional artists.



We rely on the generous support of our members to enable us to:

- Provide free admission to the Barn
- Introduce new artists, performers, arts and fine crafts to people throughout the Inland Empire, and increasingly to national and international visitors
- Continue offering creativity experiences to students in our local school district
